- Efficient Distribution: Seamless integration with your distribution network to streamline operations and enhance supply chain efficiency.
- Regulatory Compliance: TDH will strictly comply with Good Distribution Practices (GDP), Good Warehousing Practices (GWP) and Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP) respectively.

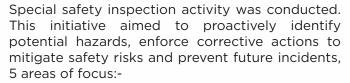
